It is an opera house in Rome opened in 1871, built by Giulio De Angelis and Francesco Marra.



Meeting with the director 23\03\17


Some students of our school went to the theatre to do an interview with the director Giulia Ferrazza, in order to discover the secrets of this world.

Why did you choose to undertake this career?

It's a fascinating world, from which it's difficult to separate. I suggest to go to the theatre at least two or three times to fall in love with it.


Furthermore don't focus too much on the study, but rather to experience next to someone who has been doing this work for years. Doing theater isn't something you can teach, you must study it in the field and live it with passion.

How has the theatre changed trough the time?

The theater initially showed the typical structure of a "Italian theater", with a shape of a "horseshoe" and with the typical stages. After the recent restructuring implemented during the end of World War II, the antlers were removed.

Currently the theater has a capacity of 830 seats in the stalls, the first and second balcony and gallery.

Compared to other theaters of Rome, the Quirino Theater is a working theater, because it hosts the tour theater companies, and the show is already ready.



Why do you think young people don't usually go to the theatre?

It happens because the family and the school don't often bring young people to the theatre. In the few cases in which teachers lead the boys to a show, it does not have a high cultural level; it is usually read plots.

A stimulus to bring the boys to the theater is the introduction of figures belonging to the television world, and able to attract a younger audience.
